

As you travel along this Romans' road, you will realize that a way of escape has been provided for you how you may receive eternal life.

Do you believe there is a God?
How can you know He exists?

ROMANS 1:20

"For the invisible things of Him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse."

By looking at the creation around you like the sun, moon, stars, birds, trees, flowers, mountains and seas, you will realize they cannot be there by chance. A big bang? Or a million years of evolution? How can it be? Looking at our human body (our complex mind, digestive system, etc), we know we must have been carefully designed and created. There must be a Great Designer behind all these creation works. We call Him God. We were once in close communion with Him, but something terrible happened destroyed this relationship. Sin has destroyed the beautiful picture. As a result the perfect world is never the same again.

ROMANS 3:23

"For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God."

We all have sin in us. We were all born in sin. We sinned because we are already sinners in the first place. As a result, we are enslaved by the power and bondage of sin. We cannot but sin. All our works of righteousness are tainted with sin and can never be accepted by God.

What then? Because we have sins, we have to suffer and die for our sins.

ROMANS 6:23a

"For the wages of sin is death..."

Sin has an ending. It results in death. This death is a double death. We will first face physical death. Then comes the second death, which is spiritual death that separates us from God for all eternity. This place of separation is found in the Lake of Fire where you will suffer in great torment and be burned forever. It is a place where you want to die and yet you can't. You and I deserve this death because of sin.

But wait, there's good news!

ROMANS 6:23b

"...But the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

There is hope beyond the grave. This hope is in Jesus Christ. Salvation is a free gift from God. There is no way you can earn this gift. All that you are needed to do is to receive it by trusting Jesus as your Lord and Saviour.

But what has He done that we should trust in Him?

ROMANS 5:8

"But God commendeth His love towards us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."

When Jesus died on the cross, He paid our sin's penalty. He bought us out of slavery to sin and death by His precious blood shed on the cross of Calvary! His love for us goes beyond any human comprehension and understanding. He loved us by giving His life for us.

How can I be saved then?

ROMANS 10:9

"That, if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved."

About 2000 years ago, the prophecy of the coming Messiah was finally realized when Jesus was born in a manger at Bethlehem. He lived a perfect life by obeying the Law of God and was crucified on the cross on our behalf. On the third day, He rose again from the dead and is now seated at the right hand of the throne of God. All these He has done, because He loves us so much.

In response to His great love for us, it is important for us to confess Him and believe in Him by faith. When we receive Him as our Lord and Saviour, He promised us forgiveness of sin and eternal life. The chain to sin will be unlocked forever. We will then take on a new lease of life that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Are you willing to take that step of faith and believe in Jesus today and be saved? If so, you may pray this prayer:

Dear Heavenly Father, I acknowledge I am a sinner and need Your forgiveness of my sins. I believe that Your Beloved Son Jesus Christ has lived, died on the Cross and rose again from the dead for me. Thank You for enabling me to receive Jesus Christ as my personal Lord and Saviour. I want to follow Jesus and obey Him all my life. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen.

After you have said this prayer, you are now a child of God. There are a few basic steps you must take when you become a Christian:

- 1) Get yourself a Bible. The best Bible version in English is the King James Bible. You are advised to begin your Bible reading from the Gospel of John in the New Testament.
- 2) Spend time with God each day. This is known as Quiet Time. You can begin with a short prayer to God, then read a portion of God's Word and close in prayer.
- 3) Look for a local Christian Church to attend where God's Word is faithfully preached and obeyed. Warning: there are many Charismatic and community churches today which are very confusing and dangerous. Those which do hold traditional worship services are likely to be safe but you must still be cautious.
- 4) Seek fellowship with other Christians and grow spiritually with them.
