

## **Measures taken by Truth BP Church in compliance with Covid-19 restrictions:**

Singapore's multi-ministry task force for Covid-19 instituted strict measures which take effect from 27 March to 30 April, which limit gatherings of not more than 10 people. In compliance with these restrictions, our church are implementing the following:

### ***1. Worship Service***

This will be streamed via YouTube live at 2.00 pm. All members are to tune in and participate in the worship service. Worshipping together in small groups of not more than 10 is encouraged.

Remember to maintain the spirit of worship at all times, taking into consideration the following:

- a. Attitude – heart preparation, in spirit and in truth.
- b. Attention – lay aside all other activities.
- c. Attire – be appropriate attired.

Tithing/Offering: As tithes and offerings cannot be collected, members can either hold on till we can gather again, or contact the church treasurer for other means of giving. Alternative methods are being looked into.

### ***2. Adult Sunday School***

Each lesson will be pre-recorded, and the link sent out to members. All are encouraged to follow the same schedule to continue with the lesson after the worship service, at 3.30 pm.

### ***3. Junior Sunday School***

Junior worship for pre-schoolers will be converted back to Sunday school lessons. Pre-recorded lessons will be sent out to parents to conduct the lessons at home.

### ***4. Young Teens Class***

The teacher will link up with the students via a social media platform to conduct the interactive lesson live.

### ***5. Prayer Meeting***

This will be streamed online via YouTube at the usual time of 8 pm on Wednesdays. Members have been organised into small groups for prayer, according to geographical location. The assigned leaders will lead in sharing and prayer. Please contact session members if you want to join a group.

### ***6. Fellowship Groups***

This will be left to each group to coordinate. In general, a social media platform will be used to continue with the programme. Members are encouraged to organise into small groups for these meetings.

### ***7. Sunrise Service will be cancelled.***

### ***8. Good Friday Service***

Please tune in to Calvary Pandan BPC's service at 7.30 pm. A link will be provided.

### ***9. Annual Congregational Meeting (ACM)***

The ACM scheduled on 18 April will be postponed. More details will be announced in due time.

### ***10. Church Bible Camp (16-19 June)***

The day camp planned at Calvary Pandan BPC premises will be put on hold, depending on the situation after 30 April.
